- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1115 hours on Friday 7th March 2025 until 2359 hours on Tuesday 11th March 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent repair works to a leaking water valve to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of United Utilities.
